Information for foreign applicants:

1. The application papers need to be handed in in German and copies of scorecards need to be translated and licensed. In case of a refusal, the application papers can only be sent back if a post-paid envelope is attached.
2. The hitherto school and musical education has to be documented without interruption.
3. Foreign applicants have to prove very good German language skills, accordingly to the level of competence B1 (class 5 to 7), level B2 (class 8 to 10) or level C1 (from class 11 sp) from the Common European Framework of References for Languages. This certificate of competences (e.g. from the Goethe-Institution) has to be attached to the application. It is recommended to visit a German evening school in the home country before applying.
4. Any costs regarding travel and residence have to be covered by the applicant.
5. An acceptance at the Music High School can only be given, when a qualifying examination, according to the Thuringia school law and regulation, is passed and a valid residence authorization according to the respective intergovernmental is available for minors. A tourist Visa is not sufficient. EU-citizens do not need any proof of this authorization.
6. In case of acceptance applicants of non-German origin have to announce a German-speaking and authorized contact person, who is entitled to residence in Germany, who takes care of the applicant at going-home weekends and in case of illness and who is able to be contacted by the school at any time.
7. The guardians have to contact the head department of school in good time before the qualifying examination in order to get at proper counsel.
8. In case of acceptance of an applicant the guardians have to take out appropriate insurances for the applicant (for ex. health and accident insurance) before school starts.
9. Only the head of school of the Music High School decides finally if the applicant will be accepted.
